Parish Council Meeting Sunday 3 July After 10am Service



On July 1, 1871 Reverend Samuel MacFarlane of the London Missionary Society anchored at Erub (Darnley Island). Dabad, a Warrior Clan Elder on Erub, welcomed the London Missionary Society clergymen and South Sea Islander evangelists and teachers.

The missionaries travelled to each of the islands spreading the gospel across the region.

1st July is known as The Coming of the Light with a yearly holiday and church services. Central to the day is a re-enactment of the landing.

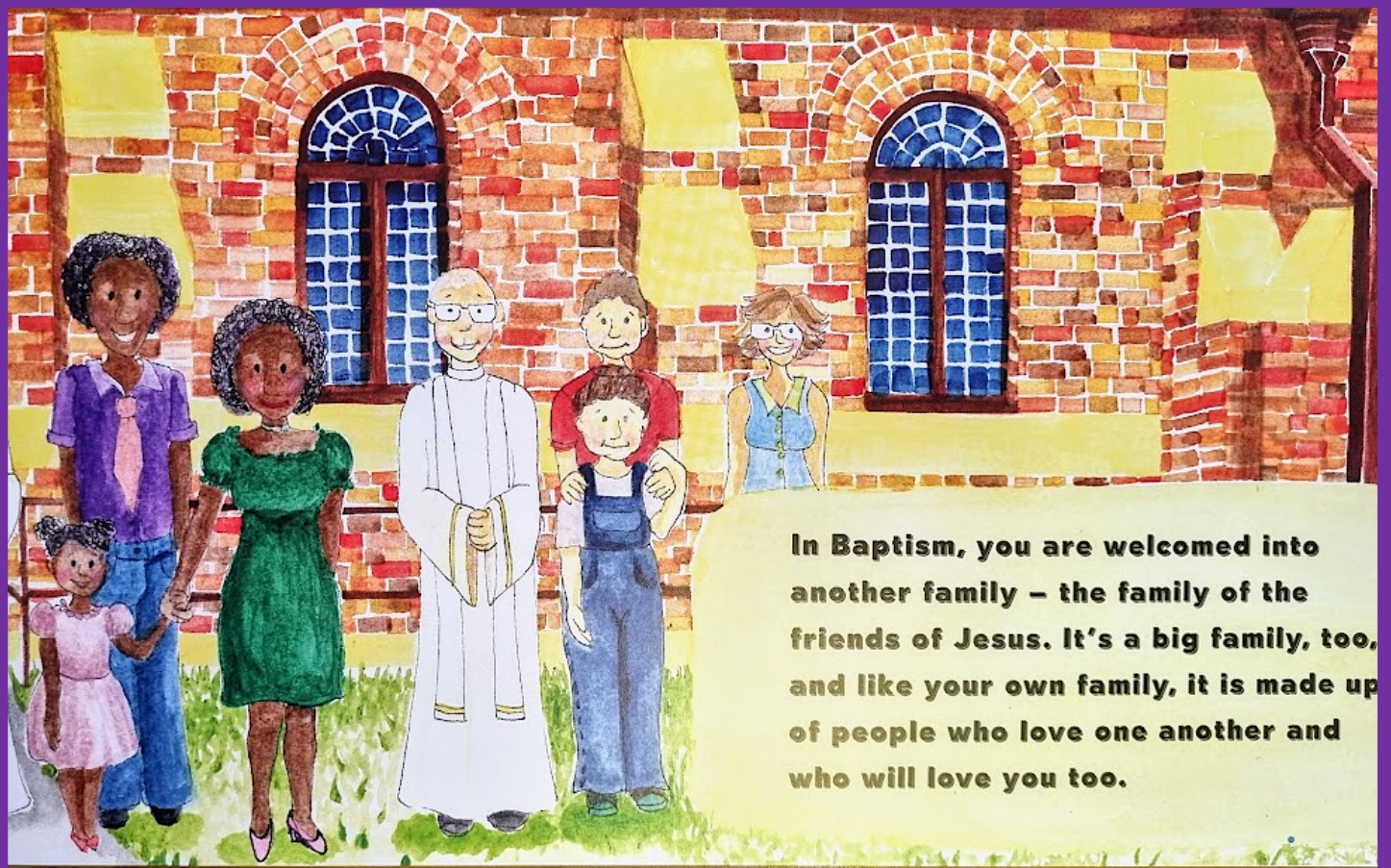
